From The Principal

Dear families,

It is hard to believe it is almost the end of term with only one newsletter to follow this edition. There is an unusual start to the next term as it begins on Tuesday 22nd April as the Monday is the Easter Monday holiday. The same week has ANZAC day falling on Friday so the first week back will be quite short indeed!

Under directions from the department we are in the process of reviewing a significant number of school policies such as our Bushfire Emergency Policy, the results of which will be conveyed to the broader school community once they have been ratified by school council. There will be a few administrative changes as a result of the reviews, two changes in particular are the administering of student medication and the procedures, protocols and expectations around school volunteers. What is happening in our classrooms...... Mrs Perry

During our reading sessions, students will recognise the story elements: characters, setting, problem and solution. In Mathematics we will work on activities related to place value, multiplication and volume and capacity.
